

## Senior Farmers' Market Nutrition Program

- Visit a farmers market on the attached list during their normal business hours to use your checks.
- Purchase only fresh, unprocessed fruits, vegetables, herbs (not potted), and honey.
- Use checks at market stands that display a "Senior Farmers' Market Nutrition Program - Checks Accepted Here" sign. Stands without this sign will not be able to cash the checks.
- Each check is worth \$3.00. You cannot receive change from a check. If your purchase is less than the amount of one or more coupons, the farmer will add more fruits and vegetables of your choice to make up the difference.
- You are welcome to use cash at the market to buy additional fresh produce. Some markets accept debit, credit, or vision cards.
- You cannot use your checks to buy items such as ornamental pumpkins, gourds, dried fruits, vegetables, or herbs, jams or jellies, or potted vegetable plants or herbs. Please keep these purchases separate.
- Checks cannot be used at grocery stores.
- Please make sure you sign your checks in advance.
- Please use all of your checks between June 1 and October 15, 2010.
