Dangerous/Vicious Animal Registration Form

City of Derby Ordinance No. 1863 requires the registration with the City of any animal that falls under the classification of vicious. Vicious meaning any animal which has been declared by a judge or an otherwise authorized authority to have exhibited a dangerous or vicious propensity towards persons or domestic animals and is capable of inflicting serious physical harm or death to humans and which would constitute a danger to human life or property.

The owner must provide a secure enclosure for the animal as proscribed in City Ord. No. 1863.

The owner must display in a prominent place at the entrance to his or her premises as well as on the pen or kennel a clearly visible warning sign indicating there is a dangerous or vicious animal on the premises.

In the event the contact information, address, or ownership of the animal should change the applicant is required to notify both the City Clerk's office and the Police Department with the new information at least seven (7) days prior to the change.
